Answers to your Election Registration and Voting Questions

The following was taken directly from the Wisconsin Government Accountability Board website on May 19th, 2016. A copy of the GAB web page follows this description. If you have further questions, or wish to register prior to an election please contact the Clerk at clerk@townofprimrose.com or call 608-4440. A private registration session can be set up as is convenient for your schedule.

Proof of Residence proves where you live, and needs to be presented by voters when registering to vote.

Acceptable Proofs of Residence are:

1. Current and valid Wisconsin driver license.
2. Current and valid Wisconsin ID card.
3. Any other official identification card or license issued by a Wisconsin governmental body or unit.
4. Any identification card issued by an employer in the normal course of business and bearing a photo of the cardholder (but not including a business card).
5. A real estate tax bill or receipt for the current year or the year preceding the date of the election.
6. A residential lease which is effective for a period that includes the registration date (but not acceptable for first-time voters registering by mail).
7. A university, college or technical institute ID card that has a photo, if voter provides a fee receipt dated within the last nine months, or if the institution provides a certified housing list to the municipal clerk that indicates citizenship.
8. A utility statement (gas, electric, telephone, mobile phone, internet, cable or satellite TV) for the period commencing not earlier than 90 days before the registration date.
9. A bank statement.
10. A paycheck
11. A check or other document issued by a unit of government.
12. A letter on public or private social service agency letterhead identifying a homeless voter and describing the individual's residence for voting purposes.

Proof of Identification proves who you are, and needs to be presented by voters when voting a ballot.

Acceptable Proofs of Identification are:

1. Current and valid Wisconsin driver license
2. Current and valid Wisconsin ID card
3. Military ID card issued by the US Uniformed Services
4. US passport book or card
5. Certificate of naturalization that was not issued more than 2 years before the date of the election.
6. Identification card issued by a federally recognized Indian tribe in Wisconsin (acceptable regardless of expiration date).
7. Drivers license receipt issued by Wisconsin DOT (valid for 45 days from date issued).
8. Photo ID issued by a Wisconsin accredited university, college or technical college (if dated, signed, no more than 2 years beyond expiration, and accompanied by proof of enrollment).
