THIS MEETING HELD BY TELECONFERENCE.

1. Call to Order at 8:07. Dale Judd, Martha Gibson, and Alex Elkins were on the call.

2. Reading and approval of Board minutes of November 2nd.

Chief Mueller had requested that the clerk correct item #6 to read “that New Glarus has 2 volunteers that, combined, serve 600 hours”. Martha moved to approve the minutes with that change. Dale seconded. Motion passed 2-0, with 1 abstention.

3. Treasurer’s report and approval of bills. Martha asked that these two items be separated. She then moved to table the treasurer’s report until Dave is able to report. Dale seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

Martha moved that Dale and Alex sign and approve the bills when they are presented for signature until Dave Garfoot returns. Alex seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

4. Public comments: Only agenda items may have action taken.

Lynn Pitman commended the Clerk for doing a great job on the election and the recount. The Clerk commended the election crew.

5. Emily Leuthner: Discussion and possible action regarding construction of 36’ x 36’ horse barn at 116 Peerless Road, parcel 0507-363-8700-5.

Ms. Leuthner explained the need to remove the current horse barn and build a new barn on higher ground. An exhibit showing the proposed location was provided. Martha moved to approve the horse barn as indicated in the exhibit supplied. Alex seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

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6. Discussion and possible action regarding comparison of Belleville EMS and New Glarus EMS. Martha felt that the points of comparison were not sufficient and she would have like to have more points compared. Alex pointed out that NGEMS is faster, more equipped, and more affordable. Alex moved to go with NGEMS. Martha seconded. Dale felt it is valuable to support all the local services. Martha agreed, but felt that response times are too critical, and New Glarus more often is fastest. Vote: Yea 2, Nay 1. Motion carried 2-1.
7. Discussion and possible action regarding the old Blue Peterbilt truck. Dale reported that he and Mike went to pick it up and the check engine light came on. The truck was returned to the shop. Possibly due to carbon in the engine from underwork (engine running too cool).
8. Discussion and possible action regarding the annual road inspection. Dale has not had the opportunity to make a first review with Mike. To be on next month's agenda.
9. Discussion and possible action regarding setting date of 2021 Caucus. Martha moved to set date for Jan 16th at 1:00 pm. Alex seconded. Motion carried 3-0. Dale questioned if we could have an in-person meeting. Alex and Martha felt that it would be better to use teleconference. Clerk to check with DCTA and/or WTA and report back on this.
10. Discussion and possible action regarding setting date of Bug Tussel Wireless CUP joint Town Board and Planning Commission meeting. Martha explained that CUPs are very formal now and require a Class II notice. The soonest the joint TB/PC meeting could legally occur is January 5<sup>th</sup>. Martha suggested Monday, January 11<sup>th</sup>, at 7:00pm. Martha felt that Glenn Reynolds should possibly be present at the meeting. Alex pointed out that the Wisconsin Statutes distinctly describe the reasons that are not grounds for denying a permit. Dale also stated that they need to show that

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they have the densities. Clerk to email link to relevant Statutes. Bug Tussel's file is too big send or post on town web site. Martha asked if the Clerk could ask County and Bug Tussel to post it somewhere with a link that everyone can open. So far, nobody has been able to open the file.

11. Discussion and possible action regarding agricultural buildings: None

12. Driveway Final Inspections: None, except Zahler's. Dale to drive by and take a look.

13. Clerk's comments: Timesheets are due. Preview draft 2021 meeting dates.
