## ANSWERING THE CALL



INCREASED CALLS: OUR FIRE/EMS CALLS ROSE 17% FROM 2020-2022. IN 2023, CALLS ARE ON TRACK TO INCREASE ANOTHER 17%. OVERLAPPING CALLS FACE UNKNOWN WAIT TIMES.



THE CREW: VOLUNTEERS SAVE FDMH OVER ONE MILLION DOLLARS ANNUALLY BUT CANNOT COVER RISING CALL VOLUMES. LOCAL MUTUAL AID PARTNERS FACE THEIR OWN STATION SHORTAGES.



**STATE AID:** ACT 12 GIVES MUNICIPALITIES 20% MORE FOR TARGETED FUNDING, INCLUDING PUBLIC SAFETY. FUNDS FROM THIS ACT COULD START FILLING STAFFING NEEDS WITHOUT TAX INCREASES.
