As a neighbor to the Deer Creek Club on Miller Road, I strongly oppose the proposed C.U.P. and rezone for the Deer Creek Club. These changes would take the club from the community organization it has historically been, and which we were always happy to have as a neighbor, to a much larger commercial-type operation with many events and hundreds of people coming in from a tri-state area, as well as even more lead from the shot and benzene from the clays being deposited in the soil. The club knows we oppose the current C.U.P. and rezone, even though their C.U.P. implies otherwise. This disconnect is perhaps reflective of the changing membership of the club, which is now primarily people who live outside our township and who, perhaps, don't care as much about the neighbors or the land and water of Primrose as its founders did.

I would like to see the club succeed as the community organization it has been historically. I strongly oppose any C.U.P. or rezone of land that expands its operation to and for commercial-type activities and that does not include a plan for remediation of the current contamination and provide a plan for using best practices moving forward.
